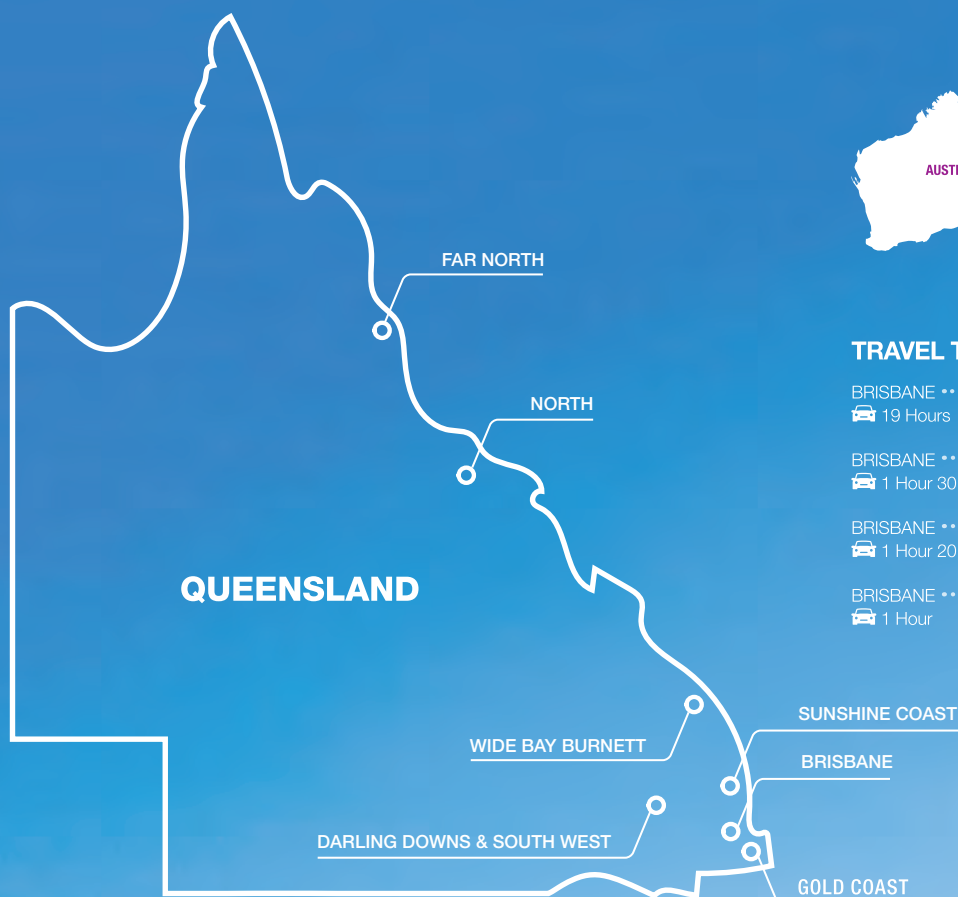

Creative art Cosmopolitan art skills

This workshop focusses on developing traditional skills and techniques and develops participants understanding of contemporary culture, both historically and theoretically. It explores how contemporary arts interface with digital technologies and expands into cross media and multi-disciplinary visual arts practice.

 - » Introduction to contemporary printmaking technique
 - » Introduction to contemporary ceramics
 - » Graphic design – personal logo (maximum of 10 participants)
 - » Floristry – construct a floral button hole (only available at South Bank, Brisbane)
 - » Jewellery making (only available at South Bank, Brisbane).
- Workshop duration – Approximately 6 hours each workshop, depending on topic.
- Requirement – maximum of 15 participants per group.

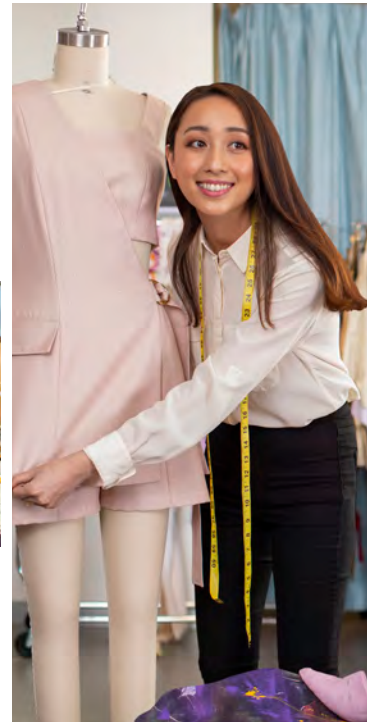
Fashion design

Information technology

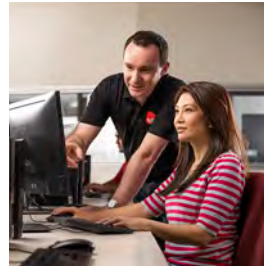
Learn the latest trends in cyber security, information technology fundamentals such as; hardware, software and networking.

Skill trades training

Customised proposal and quotation

TAFE Queensland will provide customised program itineraries and quotation based on the requirements listed on the Study Tour Booking Form. The quotation fees may include (but not be limited to):

- all workshops and classes at TAFE Queensland
- welcome and farewell activities
- interpreter for all workshops (if required)
- industry visits (if required)
- excursion over the weekend (if required)
- airport transfer (if required)
- daily meals (if required)
- accommodation (if required)
- free access to Wi-Fi while on campus
- transfers to industry visits (if required)
- Certificates of Participation.

Quotations will exclude:

- air travel and transit for participants Visa application fee (if applicable)
- travel and health Insurance - please note that TAFE Queensland has a preferred health insurance provider, Allianz, for visitor and overseas student visa insurance (ovhcallianzassistance.com.au)
- activities and transfers that occur outside of the TAFE Queensland program.

Responsibilities

- TAFE Queensland does not accept any responsibility for matters occurring outside of training hours. It is expected that the client (or accompanying tour leaders) will be responsible for all participants.
- The Client is to arrange appropriate travel insurance for all participants.
- Whilst in Australia and undertaking the program, the participants must comply with all local laws, TAFE Queensland policies and procedures, and the reasonable directions of TAFE Queensland.
- The Client must ensure that the participants behave in a manner which is not likely to damage the reputation of TAFE Queensland.
- The participants are responsible for ensuring that they attend the workshops and activities listed in their itinerary at the times specified.
- The Client is responsible for supplying a list of student details and contact details for the tour leader(s).
- Participants must be over 16 years old and accompanied by a tour leader or teacher.
- Quotation proposal must be signed 6 weeks prior to arrival to Australia.
- Payment of the Study Tour Quotation is due three weeks prior to the arrival to Australia.
- Client will be charged the full amount in the signed quotation, irrespective of whether the minimum number of participants is not reached upon departure.

Pre-arrival cancellation and refund

- If the client cancels the tour and provides more than two weeks written notice prior to arrival, the fee will be refunded in full.
- If the client cancels the tour and provides less than two weeks written notice prior to arrival, the AUD\$150 administration fee will be forfeited. Any remaining funds will be refunded.
- If the client's visa is denied and has provided a minimum of three business days notice, the full fee will be refunded. If the required notice is not provided, TAFE Queensland will retain AUD\$150 administration fee, and any remaining funds will be refunded.
- If less than the minimum number of participants arrives, there will be no refund to those who were unable to travel. The full price of the program will still apply.
- If more than the maximum number of participants arrives, an additional fee will apply, per
- additional participant.

Minimum requirements

- Participants have to be over 16 years old at the time of arrival.
- Minimum group size is 10 participants. Some programs have a maximum group size due to workplace health and safety requirements.
